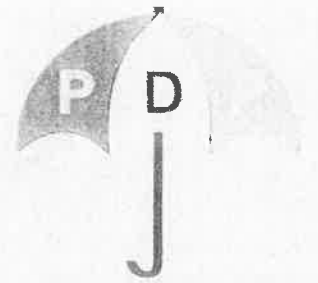

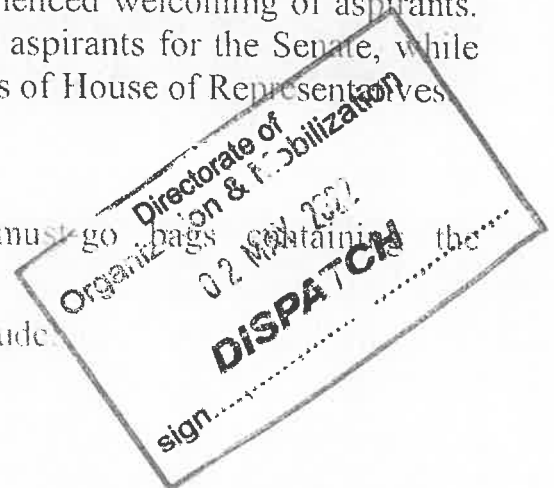
(3) **ASPIRANTS REPORTING:**

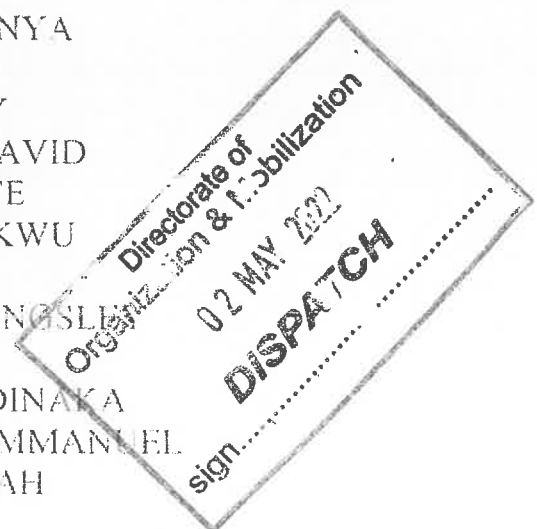

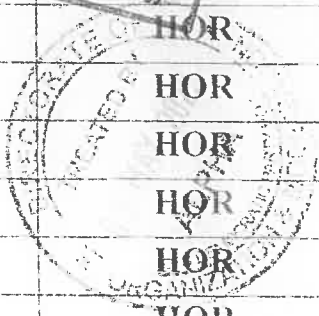

1. Hon. Nzeribe Chukwumaeze Marcelinus

Consideration has been given to the documentations presented to the committee by Hon. Nzeribe Chukwumaeze Marcelinus, alongside the Petition (s) against him.

Observations:

- a. He deliberately misinformed or lied to the Party in his Nomination Form.
- At **Column 12 of the Nomination Form**, the question was asked if he had ever been tried by any Court of law. He answered in the Negative, suggesting that he had never been tried by any Court of law.
- We have in our possession, a Court Order in Charge No. CR/791/2020, between FRN v. Hon. Chuma Nzeribe, before Hon. Justice Y. Halilu. On 17th December 2020, Hon. Chuman Nzeribe was admitted to bail, after he pleaded not guilty to the charges on 16th December 2020.
- He subsequently **breached the bail terms and jumped bail**. This necessitated the Court on 21st March 2022 to make the Orders under reference, to wit:

“IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

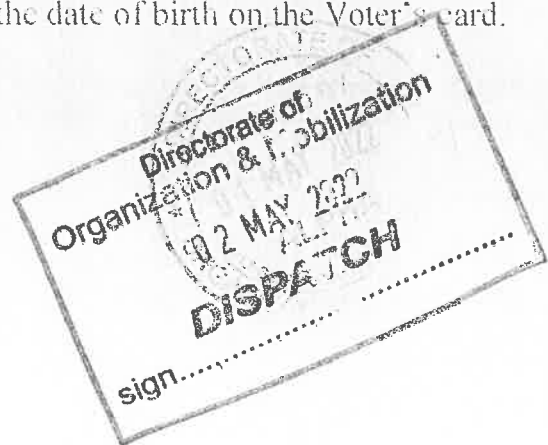
- a. That the bail of the accused person (Hon. Chuma Nzeribe) has been abused and breached as it related to the conditions. **The said bail being contractual between the court and the accused person having been breached, is hereby revoked.**
 - b. **Bench Warrant is hereby issued against the said Hon. Chuma Nzeriba for his arrest.**
 - c. **Court hereby orders** that the Inspector General of Police (IGP), Commandant General of Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC), Chairman Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) and Director General Department of State Services (DSS) **to track and arrest him.**
 - d. The Defendant (Hon. Chuma Nzeribe) **shall be kept in Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) custody once arrested, for onward prosecution in Court.”**
- The above orders show that the **Hon. Nzeribe Chukwumaeze Marcelinus is a wanted fellow**, against whom a Bench Warrant has been issued, for his arrest
- b. Also, in Column 5 of the Expression of Interest Form, the question was asked, if Hon. Nzeribe Chukwumaeze Marcelinus had been indicted of any criminal offence, by a Court or Tribunal.
 - He deliberately avoided this question, thereby presenting an incomplete form.
 - Also, the avoidance was intended to mislead the party and lead it to arrive at an inaccurate assessment.

- Lastly, **he lied on oath**, in breach of the Oath of Declaration, which states as follows:

" I, Name in full.....hereby declare that the information contained in code PD002/NA Form is **without reservation and equivocation true** and correct. I have accepted full responsibility for the correctness of every statement and accept that any information found to be false, inaccurate, mislead the party or its agents from making proper assessment of my competence to contest the Senatorial Election under the platform of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) automatically disqualifies my candidacy."

The avoidance of providing information on the arrest order is an equivocation. It was intended to mislead the party from making a proper assessment of his competence.

- c. **There are too many inconsistencies in the name of the Aspirant.** Unfortunately, there is **no Affidavit to reconcile all these fundamental discrepancies.** In the forms filled, he has the name: Hon. Nzeribe Chukwumaeze Marcellinus. In the documents attached, there are conflicts, such as:
 - The Harvard University Certificate on Public Financial Management : **Chuma** Marcellinus Nzeribe
 - The International Petroleum Management Certificate Program: **Chuma** Nzeribe
 - First School Leaving Certificate: **Mercellinus** Nzeribe
 - Voter's Card : Nzeribe, Marcellinus **Chuk**
- d. The date of birth in the Forms, is different from the date of birth on the Voter's card.




